NO PERMITS ISSUED FOR JULY 2ND - 4TH

- RV Washing Permit, \$25 per day
 - May be purchased at the Reservations Office

 - Non-refundable
 - Permits cannot be transferred to another owner, associate, or member
 - Must be displayed in the RV window during washing
 - RV must be on-site to wash
 - No washing over Major Holidays or Special Events
 - Rule violations are subject to a fine, due immediately. The account will no longer be allowed to purchase permits.

VIOLATIONS & INCIDENTALS

Fee Schedule

To protect Resort property and ensure fairness for all Owners, Members, Associates, and Guests, a valid credit card is required for all overnight reservations and select services.

The card on file authorizes Lost Valley Lake Resort to charge for unpaid balances, damages, cleaning, fines, policy violations, or additional services incurred during your stay in accordance with the Owner Guide and Resort Policies. This authorization does not apply to annual fees, or other account balances.

See Owner/Member Guidebook for complete Official Rules.

Incidentals may include, but are not limited to:

Damages & Missing Items

- Damage to rental units, campsite, furnishings, fixtures, equipment, appliances, or Resort property: Labor, supplies, and replacement cost.
- Excessive Cleaning Fees: Minimum one night rental rate
- Lost Key: \$13
- Lost/Damaged TV remote: \$35
- Pet in non-pet unit: \$50 fine + \$150 minimum Cleaning Fee, and possible Biohazard fee
- Missing/damaged dishware, utensils, pot & pans, linens, pillows, blankets: Current replacement cost plus 20% restock fee
- Equipment not returned or damaged (boats, recreation equipment, etc.) replacement cost plus 20% restock fee, labor, supplies, loss of rental privileges.
- Damage caused by improper RV hose use below 36°: Labor & Supplies Cost

Reservation & Cancellation Fees

- Unapproved Late Check-Out: ½ day rental fee
- Unapproved Late Check-Out, Owner Site, \$50
- Overnight Late Cancellation (Rental Unit): 1st night rental rate
- Overnight Late Cancellation (Site): \$25 + applicable spot/setup/teardown fees
- No Call / No Show (Site): \$35 + applicable spot/setup/teardown fees
- No Call / No Show (Rental Unit): ½ total reservation cost
- Spot Fees: See Pg 12
- Reservation Change Fee: \$25
- Unattended Campsite >48-hour violation: \$25 per night per site
- Guest overage: as applicable

Fines & Violations

- 1st Offense: Warning depending on offense
- 2nd Offense: \$25 fine
- 3rd Offense: \$50 fine
- 4th Offense: \$75 fine + possible suspension

- Illegal Parking
 - Parking on Empty Site Violation
 - Fine & any fees associated w/ clearing the site for its intended use
- Speeding
- Underage Driving
- Wreckless Driving
- Driving while under the influence
- Unsupervised children under age 13 while you are elsewhere on the Resort
- Unattended campfire
- Failure to obey burn ban

- Quiet Time violation
- Ebike: Proper equipment violation
- Pet policy violations
 - such as pet records not on file, failure to clean up after pet, pet damages to LVL property
- Cutting trees for firewood
- Curfew violation
- Food or drink in unauthorized areas

Other Fines & Violations

- RV Washing Violation: \$50 fine, due immediately
- RV Storage
 - Derelict RV Fine, \$65 per month
 - Failure to Remove RV due to Usage Code Violation, \$65 per month
 - Non-Compliance, \$65 per month
 - Movement Form Violation (Failure to complete form), \$65
- Fire Ring Misuse (trash), ½ Current Labor Rate
- RV Site, Trash Cleanup, Currently Hourly Labor Rate
- Marijuana Policy Violation, \$150 + forfeit of rental fees + cleaning fees (as applicable)
- Smoking in a non-smoking unit, \$150 cleaning fee
- Waste (improper disposal), Penalties, fines, and/or expulsion



Guest / Minor Children Supervision

- Guest
 - Owners / Members must be present on the Resort property at all times while their guests are on-site.
 - 1st Violation: Suspension of guest privileges for one (1) year
 - 2nd Violation: Suspension of guest privileges for one (1) year & a \$100 fine
 - 3rd Violation: Permanent loss of guest privileges
- Minor Children
 - Children under the age of thirteen (13) must be supervised at all times by a responsible individual eighteen (18) years of age or older while on Resort property.
 - 1st Violation: Suspension of Resort privileges for thirty (30) days
 - 2nd Violation: Suspension of Resort privileges for thirty (30) days and a \$100 fine
 - 3rd Violation: Suspension of Resort privileges for one (1) year

Biohazard & Excessive Cleaning

- Biohazard Cleaning Fee, \$250
- Mattress or Upholstery Replacement, Actual cost +20% admin charge
- Room Downtime Recovery Fee, \$150 per night if taken out of service

All facilities are used at your own risk.

*Owners are responsible for the conduct of their guests, associates, and pets.
Charges will reflect actual repair, replacement, cleaning, labor, or policy-based amounts as outlined in the Owner Member Guide.*

Cardholders will be notified of charges within 72 hours whenever reasonably possible.
